OLD BUSINESS:

1. Update on the soccer field:

- a. Jeff measured and placed soccer nets in the correct locations. Jeff and Gary will paint the lines on the fields. Jeff also said the Soccer Field signs are ready for installation.
- b. There was no discussion on the Storage Shed for the Soccer Field.

2. Playground completion:

- a. Timbers will be ordered for the completion of the playground enclosure.
- b. The playground mulch will be moved and tarped, putting it on the cement pad on the south side of the brick road.
- c. The discussion of the granite benches was put on hold.
- d. The bollards from AEP will be used as barriers at the Sewage Plant.
- e. Completion of the playground set from South School has been put on hold.

4. Arbor Day will be Friday, April 29th.

- a. The "6x6" zinc memorial plaques for Norm Lyons and Lloyd Householder will be ordered from Logan Monument.
- b. The memorial for Norm Lyons will be held on Saturday, May 21st at 2:00 PM
- c. The memorial for Lloyd Householder will be held on Saturday, May 15th at 2:00 PM.

5. Swimming pool work update to be completed in April. There are more things to be completed during the month of May in order to be ready for the pool opening.

- a. motor replaced
- b. soap dispenser is to be mounted at the employees sink
- c. toilets and seats need to be secured
- d. order wind resistant umbrellas
- e. the main pool flow meter needs to be replaced
- f. the new Rule Sign needs to be mounted to the wall
- g. electrical outlets need to be changed to GFCI Outlets
- h. Eye Washing Station needs to be installed
- i. lights in the restroom need to be replaced or fixed
- j. the baby pool will be sand blasted and painted.

6. Meet with Rose Ann Elliott to determine pool dates, hours, and times for the pool.
7. Two lifeguards have applied for lifeguard positions.
8. In order to be economically efficient, Jeff will be ordering from one supply company for the pool.

MISALANEOUS

1. Golf Frisbee installation was started on Saturday, April 2nd. All the wooden posts were installed. The rest of the installation will be completed, shortly. It was suggested when the rules for the course are made, there needs to be a disclaimer stating "When baseball and soccer games are taking place, Golf Frisbee players are to circumvent those areas.
2. We need to order American flags for the main office and McCandlish Corner.
3. Jeff has ordered cement drill bits to be used to drill holes for the Park signs at the corners of Marietta and Broad, and East Main Street and Broad.
4. Work Day for the Horseshoe pitchers will be April 26. Before that date, the restroom floors need to be cleaned and painted and the water turned on.
5. The park water fountain needs to be turned on. It was suggested that Byron take off the filter at the water fountain, to help with the flow of water through the lines.
