

✓ Ordinance No. 1351 Passed 12/9/ 1974

AN ORDINANCE TO PROHIBIT LITTERING OF STREETS, ALLEYS, OR PUBLIC GROUNDS WITHIN THE VILLAGE OF BREMEN, OHIO, AND SETTING PENALTY THEREFORE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of Bremen, State of Ohio.

SECTION 1. No person shall throw, deposit or cause to be thrown or deposited, any dirt, paper, sweepings, or of any store, house or office, ashes, shavings, offal, straw, wood, stones, earth manure, grass or refuse, matter or rubbish of any kind what-ever, upon any street, alley or public ground.

SECTION 2. Whoever violates any provision of Section 1 of this Ordinance shall be fined not more than fifty dollars (\$50.00).

SECTION 3. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage, approval and publication as provided by law.
