1. The big pool has been power washed, acid bath, spot painted, and is currently being filled.
2. Baby pool has been power washed, acid bath, completely painted, and filled with water.
3. Caleb Auman out of Canal Winchester (work 614- 834-1144, cell 740-438-9672). Billy got a quote on what work will be performed and the dollar amount.
4. InLine came in and sucked out the sand in the tank. 128 (50 lbs.) was loaded manually in order to refill the tank on Monday, May 6, 2024.
5. The greeting window was cut out and reframed. This should make better clearance for lifeguards to view the entrance hallway.
6. Lifeguards are currently being interviewed for a position. We received many applications this year due to pool closures this year.
7. The hallway, office and restrooms will be power washed and repainted.
8. The pool is scheduled to open on Saturday, May 25, 2024.
9. On Thursday, May 23, 2024 the grade school is scheduled for a pool party during the day
10. New ramp access around the shelter house and fire pit has been installed.
11. Troy planted five new trees in the park.
12. Mike who made the picnic tables last year has volunteered to make a bench for the park (island) on Fort Street.
13. Electrical wiring and boxes are currently being installed in the park. Work is being done by Tri-County School.
